I very recently went to Basic Cable from Digital service for economic reasons, so I no longer have the digital guide, but the TV Guide Channel (Channel 6) was perfectly adequate for my use. Two days later, Mediacom discontinued this channel, with a message in its place saying that listings are available on line or in the newspaper.</p> <p>This is unsatisfactory for several reasons. First, my computer is not in my living room. I should not have to go back and forth between rooms to see what's on and when. Many people don't even have Internet access. Second, I, like many folks, don't get a daily newspaper. Third, the guide in the Sunday paper does not list all the channels, MSNBC for example.</p> <p>Mediacom needs to reinstate the TV Guide Channel, or else lower their rates if they're going to delete this service. Based on my past experiences with this company, I feel sure that they are doing this to prevent more people from switching back to Basic Cable as I have done. I also feel that conversation needs to be reopened into their practices and an alternate cable company needs to be considered.
