

## HAZELWOOD CEMETERY RULES AND REGULATIONS

Fresh cut flowers, artificial flowers, or wreathes may be placed on graves at any time and will be removed by cemetery employees when they become unsightly. Containers, other than the permanent type, used for this purpose will be disposed of when flowers are removed from the grave. There are no facilities at Hazelwood Cemetery for storage of flower containers. Shepherd staff/hooks are not permitted.

Approval for plantings and erection of stones on cemetery lots must be obtained from the Hazelwood administration office. People wishing to plant trees must obtain a tree permit from the Hazelwood office. PLEASE ---- NO SHRUBS ARE ALLOWED! All charges against a cemetery lot must be paid before a grave can be opened or a stone erected.

In order to keep the cemetery in a neat and attractive condition, general cleanups will be made on approximately March 1<sup>st</sup>, June 5<sup>th</sup>, and August 1<sup>st</sup>, each year. Everything on the ground in the way of mowers and weed eaters will be disposed of. Lot owners who have any vases or wreathes that they wish to save should remove them before these dates. We request that Christmas decorations not be placed on the grave until after December 1<sup>st</sup>, in order to not interfere with leaf mulching. Please remove all Christmas decorations before March 1<sup>st</sup> in preparation for Spring.
