AN ORDINANCE

1 AUTHORIZING the City Manager, or his designee, to enter into an Eighth Amendment
2 to the 800 MHz Trunked Radio System Participation Agreement,
3 Contract No. 2000-0182-07, to expand the license pool from 300
4 licenses to 600 licenses.

7 WHEREAS, on April 13, 2000, the City of Springfield, the Greene County, and
8 Springfield City Utilities entered into an 800 MHz Trunked Radio System Participation
9 Agreement (Participation Agreement) for the administration and management of a
10 countywide 800 Megahertz (MHz) Trunked Radio System (TRS), with a First Amendment
11 entered on July 1, 2003, a Second Amendment on January 19, 2006, a Third Amendment
12 on March 20, 2008, a Fourth Amendment on July 12, 2010; a Fifth Amendment entered
13 into on August 2, 2012, a Sixth Amendment entered into on October 31, 2013, and a
14 Seventh Amendment on entered into October 2, 2014; and

16 WHEREAS, the parties to the Participation Agreement agree to accept the Eighth
17 Amendment as set forth in the attached "Exhibit A."

19 NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT ORDAINED BY THE COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF
20 SPRINGFIELD, MISSOURI, as follows, that:

22 Section 1 - The City Council hereby authorizes the City Manager, or his designee,
23 to enter into an Eighth Amendment to the 800 MHz Trunked Radio System Participation
24 Agreement with the County of Greene and Springfield City Utilities, substantially identical
25 in form and content as attached "Exhibit A."

EXPLANATION TO COUNCIL BILL NO: 2016- 174

FILED: 07-05-16

ORIGINATING DEPARTMENT: City Manager's Office

PURPOSE: Authorizing the City Manager, or his designee, to enter into an Eighth Amendment to the 800 MHz Trunked Radio System (TRS) Participation Agreement. This Amendment 8 expands the pool from 300 licenses to 600 licenses.

BACKGROUND INFORMATION: Amendment 3 to the 800 MHz Trunked Radio System (TRS) Participation Agreement established a pool of 150 TRS licenses for use by agencies that are neither participants in the TRS Agreement nor paying users of the TRS. Allocation of a pool license requires unanimous consent of the TRS Board. With the sole exception of the BNSF Railroad Police (2 radios), only government agencies have been approved. In general, agencies fall into two categories:

1. The agency's geographical area of responsibility falls largely within Greene County; these are mostly police, fire, offices of emergency management, or public works departments.
2. The agency is state or federal (US Marshalls, DEA, FBI, BATF, Missouri Highway Patrol, and Department of Conservation). These agencies have their own radio nets for internal communications and use ours only for interoperability with local users of our system or as a backup in case their network fails. For example, DEA works extensively with our local police departments and the Sheriff's Department. Our radio system supports those joint operations.


Amendment 6 expanded the pool to 300 units, but 296 licenses have been approved so the pool is nearly exhausted.

Amendment 8 expands the pool to 600 licenses. The TRS has sufficient reserve capacity to handle these additions, as well as anticipated future needs of TRS participants.

The amendment makes no other changes.

Supports the following Field Guide 2030 goal(s): Chapter 11, Public Safety; Major Goal 2, Strengthen interagency collaboration between local and regional response agencies; Objective 2a, Utilize and strengthen public and private partnerships to foster hazard mitigation program implementation and Emergency Management Accreditation Program (EMAP) certification.

**EIGHTH AMENDMENT TO THE 800 MHz TRUNKED
RADIO SYSTEM PARTICIPATION AGREEMENT**

On this ____ day of _____, 2016, the City of Springfield, Missouri ("City"), Greene County, Missouri ("County"), and City Utilities of Springfield, Missouri ("City Utilities") agree to amend the 800 MHz Trunked Radio System Participation Agreement, entered into among them on April 13, 2000, and amended on July 1, 2003, January 19, 2006, March 20, 2008, July 12, 2010, August 2, 2012, October 31, 2013, and October 2, 2014, as follows:

- 1. Substitute the following for Section 3.1:

Section 3.1. Each Party shall purchase its own Subscriber Units, dispatch consoles, and building distribution amplifiers. The Parties shall purchase such equipment under City Utilities' Contract No. 274-C or subsequent contract. Subscriber Units and dispatch consoles are allocated as follows:

<u>Party</u>	<u>Subscriber Units</u>	<u>Dispatch Consoles</u>
City Utilities	1,500	1
County	1,500	5
City	1,500	9
Nonparticipant Pool	600	0

By a unanimous vote, the TRS Management Board may allocate the Subscriber Units in the Nonparticipant Pool to public safety entities or utilities that are not party to this Agreement. Such public safety entities or utilities shall not be required to pay any of the costs of the Trunked Radio System or any fees for its use, other than the cost of the Subscriber Units allocated to them.

- 2. All other provisions shall remain unchanged.
