COUNCIL BILL NO. 2010 - 036 SPECIAL ORDINANCE NO. _____

AN ORDINANCE

1 AUTHORIZING the City Manager, or his designee, and the Springfield-Greene
2 County Park Board to accept donations for improvements to the
3 Soccer Facilities at the Cooper Family Park, and to amend the
4 budget for the City of Springfield, Missouri, in the Parks
5 Department by increasing revenues and expenditures for Park's
6 County-Wide Capital Projects Fund 4121 for fiscal year 2009-2010
7 in the amount of \$1,500,000.00, and to do all things necessary to
8 carry out the acceptance and use of all such donations, including
9 the execution of contracts.

12 WHEREAS, the City of Springfield, Missouri, by and through the Springfield-
13 Greene County Park Board, in partnership with Lake Country Soccer, Inc., is seeking
14 up to \$1,500,000 in donations and contributions for improvements to the Soccer
15 Facilities at the Cooper Family Park, which includes two donations of \$400,000 each for
16 these improvements; and

18 WHEREAS, this amendment to the budget provided for the City of Springfield,
19 Missouri, for the fiscal year 2009-2010 has been approved and recommended by the
20 City Manager of the City of Springfield and the department or agency head concerned.

22 NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT ORDAINED BY THE COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF
23 SPRINGFIELD, MISSOURI:

25 Section 1 – That the City Manager, or his designee, and the Springfield-Greene
26 County Park Board are hereby authorized to accept donations and contributions of up
27 to \$1,500,000, and to do all things necessary to carry out the acceptance and use of
28 these donations, including the execution of contracts.

30 Section 2 - That the Park Department's budget for the fiscal year 2009-2010 of
31 the City of Springfield, Missouri, is hereby amended in the accounts and in the amounts
32 as shown on Budget Adjustment No. 0046, a copy of which is attached hereto and
33 incorporated herein by reference as "Exhibit A".
34

35 Section 3 - The Council finds that the budget adjustment made by this Council
36 Bill has been recommended by the City Manager.
37

38 Section 4 - The City Manager is directed to cause the appropriate accounting
39 entries to be made in the books and records of the City. In the event additional funding
40 is provided under these donations by the donors, the Director of Finance for the City is
41 hereby authorized to adjust this appropriation by an amount not to exceed 20% of the
42 sum shown in "Exhibit A".

EXPLANATION TO COUNCIL BILL NO. 2010 -

ORIGINATING DEPARTMENT: Parks

PURPOSE: This is a requested budget adjustment to increase revenues and expenditures for the Park's County-Wide Capital Projects Fund 4121.


BACKGROUND: To authorize the Springfield-Greene County Park Board to accept donations from the Harry Cooper and Rick McQueary families for the purpose of improvements to the Soccer Facilities at Cooper Family Park. These funds will allow improvements including, but not limited to: synthetic turf on two fields; updating lighting, bleachers, scoreboards and other amenities; updating technological standards at the facility, etc. These donations will be used toward these improvements, which may cost up to \$1,500,000.

REMARKS: The Springfield-Greene County Park Board, along with Lake Country Soccer, has been working on proposed improvements to the Soccer Facilities at Cooper Family Park. Donations from the Harry Cooper and Rick McQueary families will total \$800,000, with up to an additional \$700,000 to be received contingent upon possible donations to be used for additional field turf, updating of lighting, bleachers, scoreboards and other amenities, including updating of technological standards at the facility, ect.


