ORIGINATING DEPARTMENT: Public Works

PURPOSE: Approving a resolution and the plans, construction specifications, and the bid of Wickman Gardens, Inc. for landscape irrigation at the Campbell Avenue & Olive Street Parking Lot.

BACKGROUND: The existing parking facility does not have adequate soil to retain water needed to insure plant growth. This system will provide water to establish plantings during the first three (3) years of life and during future times of low rainfall.


REMARKS:
