9 lowest responsible bidder for construction of a lift station and wastewater forcemain,

16 Section 1 - That the City Council of the City of Springfield, Missouri, hereby
17 approves the plans, construction specifications, and bid of LS&C Development
18 Services, Inc., a locally owned company, for the cost of labor and materials for
19 construction of a lift station and wastewater forcemain, extending from the Springfield
20 Sanitary Landfill to the NWTP, and approving the price and sum set forth in said bid,
21 except as said sum may be lawfully increased or decreased by the actual quantities of
22 work units involved.
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24 Section 2 – This resolution shall be in effect immediately upon adoption.
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

EXPLANATION TO COUNCIL BILL NO. 2010 -

ORIGINATING DEPARTMENT: Public Works

PURPOSE: To accept the bid of LS&C Development Services, Inc., a locally owned company, for the construction of a lift station and wastewater forcemain, extending from the Springfield Sanitary Landfill to the Northwest Wastewater Treatment Plant.

REMARKS:

HISTORY

1. Currently an average of 10.5 million gallons of landfill wastewater (leachate) is transported by tanker truck to the Northwest Wastewater Treatment Plant for treatment, resulting in transportation costs of approximately \$175K annually. Operating cost savings from the elimination of hauling operations will result in recovery of pipeline construction costs in approximately ten years.
2. This project will allow for the elimination of five tanker trucks, traveling over 43,000 miles per year, saving 7,750 gallons of diesel fuel and 172,000 pounds of greenhouse gas (CO²) emissions each year.
3. Special Ordinance No. 25647 passed by City Council on August 24, 2009, approved a budget adjustment in the amount of \$1.98M for design and construction of the landfill wastewater forcemain.
4. Plans, specifications, and a cost estimate have been prepared by Aquaterra Environmental Solutions of Springfield Missouri and are on file.
5. Wastewater from this pipeline would flow to the Northwest Wastewater Treatment Plant.
6. Pipeline will be located in MoDOT utility corridor adjacent to Highway 13.
7. Temporary construction easements to allow for road crossings have been acquired.
8. The project was advertised in the *Daily Events* on December 7, 2009, through December 11, 2009.

9. Bids were opened in the Busch Building on February 5, 2010, at 2:00 p.m. The following bids were received:




