## Information Sought on Attempted Robbery

**For January 27, 2009**

CRIME STOPPERS and the Springfield Police are asking for help identifying the suspects in an attempted robbery.

The robbery occurred at 1:53 pm on January 19th at the Heritage Cafeteria located at 1364 E Battlefield in Springfield. The two suspects arrived at the restaurant approximately 30 minutes earlier and looked around the facility then left. When the suspects returned, they looked around the facility again, then quickly approached the front counter and displayed a gun to an employee while demanding money. The employee refused and the suspect left soon after when a customer started approaching. The suspects left the area in an unknown direction of travel.

The suspects were described as follows:

-#1 (Subject with Gun): white male, 5'10" to 5'11" with thin build weighing approximately 145-150 pounds. He had light brown hair and a thin mustache. Suspect #1 was wearing a red baseball cap, faded light blue hooded sweatshirt and blue jeans.

-#2: white male 5'6" or 5'7" with thin build weighing approximately 130-135 pounds. Suspect #2 was described as having bad teeth. He was wearing a camouflage baseball cap and a faded black hooded sweatshirt.

If you were in the area of this robbery and saw any suspicious people or vehicles at these times, or if you know the suspects, please call Crime Stoppers.
