Information Sought on Two Recent Robberies

For August 19, 2009

CRIME STOPPERS and the Springfield Police Department are asking for help identifying the suspects in two recent robberies.

The first robbery occurred on August 11, 2009 at 2:52 a.m. at the Kum N Go Convenience Store located at 4020 W Battefield. The clerk was alone in the building when two suspects entered the store, displayed a gun and demanded cash. The suspects left with cash and the clerk's cell phone in an unknown direction of travel.

The second robbery occurred on August 11, 2009 at 4:49 a.m. at the Kum N Go Convenience Store located at 3030 S Jefferson. A clerk and a product vendor were in the store when two suspects entered, displayed a gun and demanded cash. The suspects stole cash from the register then fled on foot into the nearby Old Monterey apartment complex.

Suspect descriptions and surveillance footage have led investigators to believe the same suspects to be responsible for both robberies:

- Suspect #1: black male, 5 feet 10 inches tall with a medium build wearing a white t-shirt and blue bandana as a mask. He was displaying the gun during the Battlefield robbery. He was not wearing the bandana during the Jefferson robbery and was described as having a mustache.
- Suspect #2: black male 5 feet 10 inches tall with a heavy build wearing a black t-shirt and a red bandana as a mask. He was displaying the gun during the Jefferson robbery. The victims from the Jefferson robbery described him as wearing a black stocking cap.



If you were in the area of this incident and saw any suspicious people or vehicles at these times, or if you know the suspects, please call Crime Stoppers.
