Information Sought on Recent Theft of Emergency Communication Equipment

For October 19, 2009

CRIME STOPPERS and the Springfield Police Department are asking for help identifying the suspects in a recent theft and to recover emergency communications equipment.

The theft occurred in the early morning of October 14, 2009 in the 2900 Block of S Marlan in Springfield. Unknown suspects broke into a red, Mitsubishi Montero and stole several personal items and paperwork. Also taken during the vehicle break-in was a Motorola brand model 2000 fire communications radio, which is the property of a municipal fire department in the Springfield area.

There is no suspect information at this time. If you were in the area of this incident and saw any suspicious people or vehicles at these times, or if you know the suspects, please call Crime Stoppers.
