Information Sought on Recent Robbery

For November 5th, 2008

CRIME STOPPERS, the Springfield Police Department and the Federal Bureau of Investigations are asking for help identifying the suspect in a recent robbery.

The robbery occurred on October 31st at approximately 3:07 pm at the Metro Credit Union, located at 3868 South Avenue. An unknown adult male suspect entered the bank and demanded money. The victim tellers complied with the suspect's demands and provided the suspect an undisclosed amount of money. The suspect took the money and immediately fled through the entrance/exit doors of the bank. The suspect fled in his vehicle from the bank without further incident. No injuries were reported during this bank robbery.

The suspect was described as an unknown race male in his 20s or 30s, 5'9" with a slender build. The suspect was wearing a black ski mask, dark sunglasses and all black clothing. The suspect was seen driving away from the bank in a two-tone 1987 to 1991 Ford F-150 pick-up with old white or gray camper shell.
