6 growing power of active mobility and the benefits such mobility can bring to a
7 community; and

9 WHEREAS, Ozark Greenways has established a relationship with LaneShift,
10 LLC, a planning and consulting agency that exists to create bicycle and pedestrian
11 networks that move people safely and comfortably; and

13 WHEREAS, in Resolution 10439, passed on April 8, 2019, certain City Council
14 members were authorized to participate in a one-day mobility study tour of Northwest
15 Arkansas, hosted by LaneShift, LLC, and now an additional Council member desires to
16 participate.

18 NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED BY THE COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF
19 SPRINGFIELD, MISSOURI, as follows, that:

21 Section 1 – City Council authorizes Matthew Simpson to participate in the one-
22 day mobility study tour of Northwest Arkansas and hereby further authorizes payment of
23 all necessary and incidental expenses incurred by attending said tour.

25 Section 2 – Section 2.3(1) of the City Charter authorizes City Council, by
26 adopting this Resolution, to allow for Council members to be reimbursed for expenses
27 associated with participation in this tour, said reimbursement to be pursuant to Sec 2-62
28 of the City Code and established travel expense policies of the City.

30 Section 3 – This Resolution shall be in effect immediately upon adoption.


PURPOSE: Authorizing Councilmember Matthew Simpson to participate in a one-day mobility study tour of Northwest Arkansas, hosted by LaneShift, LLC.

BACKGROUND INFORMATION: The City and Ozark Greenways are eager to explore the growing power of active mobility and the benefits such mobility can bring to a community. Ozark Greenways has established a relationship with LaneShift, LLC, a planning and consulting agency that exists to create bicycle and pedestrian networks that encourage people to move safely and comfortably. LaneShift, LLC, is hosting a one-day mobility study tour of Northwest Arkansas and several members of City Council were authorized to participate in the tour in Resolution 10439, which passed on April 8, 2019.
