A RESOLUTION

1 ESTABLISHING the “Comprehensive Plan – Forward SGF Advisory Team” for the
2 purpose of providing additional citizen engagement and participation
3 during the City’s comprehensive planning process.
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6 WHEREAS, the City is in the initial stages of developing a new comprehensive
7 plan for the City; and
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9 WHEREAS, City Council wishes to include robust citizen engagement during the
10 comprehensive plan’s development process; and

13 establish an advisory team to work with City Council, the Planning and Zoning
14 Commission, City Staff, and consultants over the course of the comprehensive planning
15 process; and
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17 WHEREAS, it is City Council’s intent that the advisory team will provide part of the
18 public face of the comprehensive planning process and the establishment of said
19 advisory team will help facilitate meaningful input from citizens during the comprehensive
20 planning process; and
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22 WHEREAS, City Council intends for the advisory team to serve as a community
23 sounding board, meeting at key points of the comprehensive planning process to provide
24 advice and input to City Council, the Planning and Zoning Commission, and City staff.
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26 NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED BY THE COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF
27 SPRINGFIELD, MISSOURI, as follows, that:
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29 Section 1 – City Council hereby establishes the Comprehensive Plan – Forward
30 SGF Advisory Team which shall function as a piece of the City’s overall citizen
31 engagement process during the development of a new comprehensive plan for the City.
32 Said Advisory Team is hereby empowered and authorized to do all things necessary and
33 convenient to carry out the intent of this Resolution, including without limitation, the
34 facilitation of robust citizen engagement in the development of a new comprehensive
35 plan for the City.

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Section 2 – City Council hereby appoints those individuals identified on “Exhibit A,” which is attached hereto and incorporated herein by this reference, to the Comprehensive Plan – Forward SGF Advisory Team. The individuals provided on “Exhibit A” shall serve on said Advisory Team, with Tom Prater serving as chair, until the City has completed its most recent comprehensive planning process and adopted a new comprehensive plan for the City at the conclusion of said process.

Section 3 – This Resolution shall be in effect from and after passage.

ORIGINATING DEPARTMENT: Planning and Development

PURPOSE: Establishing the “Comprehensive Plan – Forward SGF Advisory Team” for the purpose of providing additional citizen engagement and participation during the City’s comprehensive planning process.

BACKGROUND INFORMATION: Earlier this summer the City entered into a contract with Houseal Lavigne Associates for the development of a new Comprehensive Plan. This plan will build on and, in some instances, replace the Vision 20/20 Plan developed in the late 1990’s/early 2000’s. Development of the Comprehensive Plan will include a robust citizen engagement process including establishment of an advisory team that will work with the City’s consultants and staff over the course of the next 18 to 24-month planning process.

REMARKS: The Advisory Team will provide a public face to the planning process and demonstrate a commitment on behalf of the City to seek meaningful input from citizens in the community. The Team will serve as a community sounding board, meeting at key points along the process to discuss issues and overall planning direction and provide feedback for Planning and Zoning Commission and City Council consideration. Twenty-three community members are recommended for appointment to the Forward SGF Advisory Team. Each has been recommended by the Mayor and City Council, Planning and Zoning Commission or staff to provide a diverse perspective and cross-section of the city. The term of service for the appointed Forward SGF Advisory Team will conclude with the adoption of the Forward SGF Comprehensive Plan. Approval of this Resolution and establishment of the Advisory Team will set in motion the next critical steps in the process of developing the City’s Comprehensive Plan. The attached “Exhibit A” provides a roster of those recommended to serve on the Comprehensive Plan - Forward SGF Advisory Team.
