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

**EXPLANATION TO COUNCIL BILL 2020 - 157**

FILED: 07-07-20

ORIGINATING DEPARTMENT: Finance

PURPOSE: Granting a new liquor license to sell retail liquor in the original package, including Sunday sales to SKT, LLC, d/b/a AM PM Food Mart, for their location at 529-531 South Grant Avenue, Springfield, Missouri.

BACKGROUND INFORMATION: Applicant, SKT, LLC, d/b/a AM PM Food Mart, applied for a license to sell retail liquor in the original package, including Sunday sales at its location at 529-531 South Grant Avenue. The applicant's business is located within 200 feet of property owned and/or operated by Springfield Public Schools located at 506 South Grant Avenue. Objections from the school were not submitted to City staff.


The property located at 529-531 South Grant is also located within 200 feet of residentially zoned property. Objections were submitted to City staff by residents at eligible properties. A survey was completed, and it was determined that 50 percent of property owners located at the eligible addresses have protested.


Pursuant to Section 10-37(a) of the Springfield City Code, no license shall be granted for the sale of intoxicating liquor within 200 feet of any church, school, park, or building regularly used as a place of worship unless the applicant shall first obtain the consent in writing of City Council. As a result, City Council must determine whether it will issue a license to this business location.

Pursuant to Section 36-459(5) of the Springfield City Code, if within the 21 days aforesaid there shall be filed with the officer of the city charged with receiving applications for liquor licenses a protest to granting the license for the proposed establishment signed by at least 50 percent of the owners of the land so zoned R-SF, R-TH, R-MHC or designated for single-family or two-family residential use in a PD district, and located within 200 feet of the proposed establishment, then the application shall be forwarded to City Council for its resolution in favor or against said application. If, however, no such protest shall be filed within 21 days or if the same shall be insufficient, thereupon the license may issue, all other requirements of the law of the City of Springfield having been met and complied with.
