SPECIAL ORDINANCE \_\_\_\_\_

AN ORDINANCE

1 AUTHORIZING the City Manager, or his designee, to accept a donation of 700 railroad  
2 ties, valued at \$17,780.00, from BSB Tie Company to be used by the  
3 Springfield Police Department to improve safety in their training shoot

7 WHEREAS, the Springfield Police Department (“SPD”) utilizes a shoot house for  
8 indoor firearms training; and

10 WHEREAS, the interior of the SPD shoot house is lined with railroad ties for  
11 safety; and

13 WHEREAS, over time the railroad ties have become worn and need to be  
14 replaced to improve safety; and

16 WHEREAS, BSB Tie Company has graciously agreed to donate the necessary  
17 railroad ties to replace the worn ties inside the shoot house, with SPD required to pay  
18 only the shipping expenses, which expenses are not expected to exceed \$2,800.00 and  
19 are covered in previously budgeted funds.

21 NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT ORDAINED BY THE COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF  
22 SPRINGFIELD, MISSOURI, as follows, that:

24 Section 1 – The City Manager, or his designee, is hereby authorized to accept  
25 the donation of 700 railroad ties from BSB Tie Company valued at \$17,780.00, for use  
26 in the Springfield Police Department shoot house, with the Springfield Police  
27 Department to pay for shipping expense from previously budgeted funds.

29 Section 2 – City Council greatly appreciates the donation made by BSB Tie  
30 Company and wishes to express its sincerest thanks for said donation.

32 Section 3 – This Ordinance shall be in full force and effect from and after  
33 passage.




ORIGINATING DEPARTMENT: Police

PURPOSE: Authorizing the City Manager, or his designee, to accept a donation of 700 railroad ties, valued at \$17,780.00, from BSB Tie Company to be used by the Springfield Police Department to improve safety in their training shoot house.

BACKGROUND INFORMATION: The Springfield Police Department utilizes a shoot house that is used for indoor firearms training. For safety, the interior is lined with railroad ties, which have become worn over time. To improve safety, it is necessary to reline the interior of the shoot house. BSB Tie Company has offered to donate the necessary railroad ties to replace those that are worn, at an approximate value of \$17,780.00. SPD would be required to pay the shipping costs, which are not expected to exceed \$2,800.00 and will be covered in previously budgeted funds to get the railroad ties here.
