COUNCIL BILL 2020- 194 RESOLUTION

A RESOLUTION

1 ESTABLISHING the “Forward SGF – Commercial Street Advisory Team” for the
2 purpose of providing additional citizen engagement and participation
3 during the City’s comprehensive planning process.

6 WHEREAS, the City is in the process of developing a new comprehensive plan
7 for the City; and
8

9 WHEREAS, City Council wishes to include robust citizen engagement during the
10 comprehensive plan’s development process; and
11

12 WHEREAS, as part of this robust citizen engagement, City Council desires to
13 establish an advisory team focused on Commercial Street area to work with City Council,
14 the Planning and Zoning Commission, City Staff, and consultants over the course of the
15 comprehensive planning process; and

17 WHEREAS, it is City Council’s intent that the advisory team will provide part of the
18 public face of the comprehensive planning process and demonstrate a commitment on
19 behalf of the City to seek meaningful input from citizens most familiar with the business,
20 real estate and residential dynamics on Commercial Street.

22 NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED BY THE COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF
23 SPRINGFIELD, MISSOURI, as follows, that:

25 Section 1 – City Council hereby establishes the Forward SGF – Commercial
26 Street Advisory Team which shall function as a piece of the City’s overall citizen
27 engagement process during the development of a new comprehensive plan for the City.

29 Section 2 – The Forward SGF – Commercial Street Advisory Team shall facilitate
30 and collect meaningful input from citizens during the comprehensive planning process
31 and serve as a community sounding board, meeting at key points of the comprehensive
32 planning process to provide advice and input to City Council, the Planning and Zoning
33 Commission, and City staff.

35 Section 3 – City Council hereby appoints those individuals identified on “Exhibit

36 A,” which is attached hereto and incorporated herein by this reference, to the Forward
37 SGF – Commercial Street Advisory Team. The individuals provided on “Exhibit A” shall
38 serve on said Advisory Team, with Irene Schaefer serving as chair, until the City has
39 completed its most recent comprehensive planning process and adopted a new
40 comprehensive plan for the City at the conclusion of said process.

EXPLANATION TO COUNCIL BILL 2020-194

ORIGINATING DEPARTMENT: Planning and Development

PURPOSE: Establishing the Forward SGF - Commercial Street Advisory Team for the purpose of providing additional citizen engagement and participation during the comprehensive planning process. (Staff recommends approval).

BACKGROUND INFORMATION: As part of the Forward SGF Comprehensive Planning process, the City is engaging Progressive Urban Management Associates (“PUMA”) to update the 2006 *Commercial Street Strategy for Success* and to make recommendations for optimal organizational collaboration, work program and budget to achieve the strategies outlined in the plan. Citizen engagement will be a key factor in updating the strategic plan, including the establishment of an advisory team that will work with the City’s consultants and staff over the course of the next 6-8 months.

REMARKS: The Advisory Team will provide a public face to the planning process and demonstrate a commitment on behalf of the City to seek meaningful input from citizens most familiar with the business, real estate and residential dynamics on Commercial Street. In addition, representatives from the Planning and Zoning Commission and the Forward SGF Advisory Team will serve on the Forward SGF - Commercial Street Advisory Team to provide continuity. The Team will serve as a community sounding board, to help provide planning direction and feedback for Planning and Zoning Commission and City Council consideration.

Thirteen members are recommended for appointment to the Forward SGF - Commercial Street Advisory Team. Their term of service will conclude with City Council’s consideration of the updated strategic plan. The attached “Exhibit A” provides a roster of those recommended to serve on the Forward SGF – Commercial Street Advisory Team.


