SPECIAL ORDINANCE _____

AN ORDINANCE

1 AUTHORIZING the City Manager, or his designee, to accept a grant in the amount of
2 \$1,861 from the Stephen and Helen G. Sedora Charitable Trust, to
3 provide free smoke alarms and batteries for the hearing impaired; and
4 amending the budget for the Fire Department for Fiscal Year 2020-

8 WHEREAS, the Springfield Fire Department (“SFD”) provides free smoke alarms
9 to residents who are in need in order to reduce injuries, deaths, and severity of property
10 damage as the result of a fire; and

12 WHEREAS, SFD funds its free smoke alarm program through public donations,
13 partnership support, and grants; and

15 WHEREAS, SFD applied for and received a grant from the Stephen and Helen
16 G. Sedora Charitable Trust to provide smoke alarms and batteries for the hearing
17 impaired.

19 NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT ORDAINED BY THE COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF
20 SPRINGFIELD, MISSOURI, as follows, that:

22 Section 1 – The City Manager, or his designee, is hereby authorized to accept a
23 grant in the amount of \$1,861 from the Stephen and Helen G. Sedora Charitable Trust
24 for the purchase of smoke alarms and batteries for the hearing impaired, and to do all
25 things necessary to carry out the grant, including the execution of contracts upon
26 approval as to form by the City Attorney.

28 Section 2 – The budget for Fiscal Year 2020-2021 of the Springfield Fire
29 Department is hereby amended in the accounts and in the amounts as shown on
30 Budget Adjustment No. 041, a copy of which is attached hereto and incorporated herein
31 by reference as “Exhibit A.”

33 Section 3 – City Council hereby finds that the budget adjustment made in Section
34 2 has been recommended by the City Manager.

36 Section 4 – The City Manager is directed to cause the appropriate accounting
37 entries to be made in the books and records of the City.

39 Section 5 – City Council greatly appreciates the donation and wishes to express
40 its thanks to the Stephen and Helen G. Sedora Charitable Trust.

42 Section 6 – This Ordinance shall be in full force and effect from and after

EXPLANATION TO COUNCIL BILL 2020-307

ORIGINATING DEPARTMENT: Fire

PURPOSE: To accept and appropriate grant funds in the amount of \$1,861 from the Stephen and Helen G. Sedora Charitable Trust for purchase of hearing-impaired smoke alarms and batteries; and to amend the budget.

BACKGROUND INFORMATION: The Stephen and Helen G. Sedora Charitable Trust provides financial support for programs for the hearing impaired through a grant program administered by the Central Trust Company.

The Fire Department applied for and was awarded a grant totaling \$1,861 from the Sedora Trust which will allow for the purchase of 9V batteries and smoke alarms specifically designed for the hearing impaired.

REMARKS: The Springfield Fire Department provides free smoke alarms and batteries to our community, to include specialized alarms for those with hearing impairments. Funding provided through grants and donations are critical to the sustainment of this community risk reduction program.
