GENERAL ORDINANCE _____

AN ORDINANCE

1 AMENDING Springfield City Code, Chapter 36, 'Land Development Code,' Article
2 IV. – 'Building Trades Examination and Certification Board,' Division 6.
3 – 'Fees and Licenses,' Sections 36-544(b) and 36-545(a) to shorten
4 the renewal period for trade certifications, registrations, and licenses
5 from six months to three months.

8 WHEREAS, the Building Trades Examination and Certification Board has voted
9 to recommend shortening the renewal period for trade certifications, registrations, and
10 licenses from six months to three months; and
11

12 WHEREAS, City Council finds that the board recommendations are based on
13 board experience and will enhance competence and accountability among those the
14 board certifies, registers, and licenses.

16 NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT ORDAINED BY THE COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF
17 SPRINGFIELD, MISSOURI, as follows, that:

19 Section 1 – Chapter 36, 'Land Development Code,' of the Springfield City Code

31 (b) *Renewal of master, journeyman certifications and/or apprentice registrations.* Trade
32 Certification renewals for Journeymen & Masters, and Apprentice registrations, are due

33 on an annual basis beginning on January 1 for the calendar year issued. The renewal
34 period is January 1 to ~~June 30~~ March 31 of that calendar year.

36 36-545. – Effects of failure to renew trade certificate or registration.

38 (a) Any certificate holder or registrant, who fails to renew his certificate or registration
39 annually and allows same to remain unrenewed after ~~June 30~~ March 31 must submit an
40 original application to the board. The board may require the candidate to re-test or may
41 approve the candidate to be reinstated.

EXPLANATION TO AMENDED COUNCIL BILL 2021- 011

FILED: 01-05-21

ORIGINATING DEPARTMENT: Building Development Services

PURPOSE: Amending Article IV. – ‘Building Trades Examination and Certification Board,’ Division 6 ‘Fees and Licenses,’ Section 36-544 – ‘Certification, registration, and license fees,, Subsection (b) and Section 36-545 – ‘Effects of failure to renew trade certificate or registration,’ Subsection (a). (Recommended by the Examination Board.)

BACKGROUND AND REMARKS: The Examination Board has voted to reduce the renewal period from 6 months (June 30) to 3 months making the new renewal period January 1 through March 31 of that calendar year and revise the failure to renew their certificate to reflect the same. Building Development Services will be sending out the new date of renewal to all Masters, Journeymen and Apprentices, registered with the City of Springfield as a licensed tradesperson, with the annual renewal application mailing.


The new section 36-544 (b) will read as follow: *Renewal of master, journeyman certifications and/or apprentice registrations.* Trade Certification renewals for journeymen & Masters, and Apprentice registrations, are due on an annual basis beginning on January 1 for the calendar year issued. The renewal period is January 1 to March 31 of that calendar year.

The new section 36-545 (a) will read as follow: Any certificate holder or registrant, who fails to renew his certificate or registration annually and allows same to remain unrenewed after March 31 must submit an original application to the board. The board may require the candidate to re-test or may approve the candidate to be reinstated.
