COUNCIL BILL 2018- 026

SPECIAL ORDINANCE _____

AN ORDINANCE

1 APPROVING the sale of real property located at 831 South Newton Avenue to Peter
2 Ottoson for \$5,200.00; authorizing the issuance of a deed for same;
3 and approving a budget adjustment to amend the Fiscal Year 2017-
4 2018 budget.

7 WHEREAS, the City acquired the real estate generally located at 831 South
8 Newton Avenue (the "Property") through the dangerous building program; and
9

10 WHEREAS, total acquisition costs, including legal costs, demolition costs, etc.,
11 were \$3,659.49; and

13 WHEREAS, after declaring the property to be surplus, the Land Inventory
14 Committee put it out for public bid; and
15

16 WHEREAS, Peter Ottoson has offered to buy the Property for \$5,200.00, an offer
17 the City Manager considers acceptable; and
18

19 WHEREAS, disposition of real property calls for City Council approval; and

21 WHEREAS, City Council is committed to using all available funds, whenever
22 possible, to add to the Police-Fire Pension Fund.

24 NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT ORDAINED BY THE COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF
25 SPRINGFIELD, MISSOURI, as follows, that:
26

27 Section 1 - City Council hereby approves the sale of the real estate generally
28 located at 831 South Newton Avenue and depicted on "Exhibit A," which is attached
29 hereto and incorporated herein by this reference, to Peter Ottoson for the price and sum
30 of \$5,200.00.

32 Section 2 - City Council hereby authorizes the Mayor to execute such documents
33 as are necessary to convey title to the real estate to the purchaser herein consistent

34 with the offer and acceptance.

36 Section 3 - The budget of the Department of Building Development Services for
37 Fiscal Year 2017-2018 is hereby amended in the accounts and in the amounts as
38 shown on Budget Adjustment No. 0025, a copy of which is attached hereto and
39 incorporated herein by this reference as "Exhibit B."

41 Section 4 – City Council hereby designates that unrestricted proceeds generated
42 in excess of total acquisition costs be contributed to the Police-Fire Pension Fund.

43

44 Section 5 - City Council hereby finds that the budget adjustment made above has
45 been recommended by the City Manager.

46

47 Section 6 - City Manager is directed to cause the appropriate accounting entries
48 to be made in the books and records of the City.

49

50 Section 7 - This Ordinance shall be in full force and effect from and after
51 passage.

EXPLANATION TO COUNCIL BILL 2018 -026

FILED: 01-09-18

ORIGINATING DEPARTMENT: City Manager's Office

PURPOSE: To approve the sale of real property located at 831 South Newton Avenue to Peter Ottoson for \$5,200.00; authorizing the issuance of a deed for same; and approving a budget adjustment to amend the Fiscal Year 2017-2018 budget.

BACKGROUND INFORMATION: The City acquired the property located at 831 South Newton Avenue through the dangerous building program. Total acquisition costs, including legal costs, demolition costs, etc., were \$3,659.49. After putting the property out for public bid, the city received the offer noted above. No City department needs the property and it does not have a public purpose. A real-estate conveyance requires City Council's approval. Net proceeds from the sale of the properties will be returned to the fund from which the property was purchased, up to the amount of the purchase price. City Council has stated its intent to put any additional unrestricted proceeds from surplus property sales into the Police-Fire Pension Fund.

The budget of the City for the Fiscal Year 2017-2018 is amended in the accounts and the amounts shown on "Exhibit B," Budget Adjustment No. 0025.

REMARKS: The above council bill originated with the Land Inventory Committee. Pursuant to "Administrative Memorandum #5D," the Committee has declared the above property to be surplus.




