AN ORDINANCE

1 AUTHORIZING the City Manager, or his designee, to enter into a contract with Infor
2 Public Sector, Inc., for the purpose of continuing with Phase 2 and 3
3 of the implementation of the Infor Community Regulation and
4 Development software.

7 WHEREAS, Information Systems, Building Development Services, Public Works,
8 Environmental Services, Building Development Services, Planning and Development,
9 Public Works, Environmental Services, Public Information Services, Health, and
10 Finance Departments, with the cooperation of Infor Consulting Services, are in the
11 process of implementing a new software program; and

13 WHEREAS, the new software program helps manage the permitting, inspections,
14 and payment of necessary fees for residential and commercial development; and

16 WHEREAS, if approved, Phase 2 would begin in Fiscal Year 2018-2019 and
17 Phase 3 is anticipated to be included as a budget request for Fiscal Year 2019-2020;

20 WHEREAS, the estimated cost for Phase 2 is \$538,960.00 and the estimated
21 cost for Phase 3 is \$676,580.00.

23 NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT ORDAINED BY THE COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF
24 SPRINGFIELD, MISSOURI, as follows, that:

26 Section 1 – The City Manager, or his designee, is hereby authorized to enter into
27 a contract with Infor Public Sector, Inc., for the purpose of continuing with Phase 2 and
28 3 of the implementation of the Infor Community Regulation and Development contract,
29 provided that the form of the contract is approved as to form by the City Attorney.

EXPLANATION TO COUNCIL BILL 2018 - 088

FILED: 04-03-18

ORIGINATING DEPARTMENT: Information Systems

PURPOSE: To authorize the City Manager, or his designee, to enter into a contract with Infor Public Sector, Inc., for the purpose of continuing with Phase 2 and 3 of the implementation of the Infor Community Regulation and Development software.

BACKGROUND INFORMATION: The Information Systems, Building Development Services, Planning and Development, Public Works, Environmental Services, Public Information Office, Health and Finance Departments have been working with Infor Consulting Services to implement software that will become the central repository to track and manage service requests, residential and commercial development permitting, inspection and online payments. The Infor software is currently used to maintain the public infrastructure such as streets, sidewalks, sewer and traffic signs.


This Infor software replaces permitting software that was first used by the City in the 1990s and is based on outdated technology and no longer supported by the original company that developed it. This software is critical to improving and streamlining the City's development plan review process as well as other permitting and inspection processes.

Phase 2 and 3 of the implementation will include code enforcement, additional permits, business licenses, Health inspections, Fire permits, special event permits, and more. It will also encompass online application and payment capabilities and electronic notifications throughout the permitting process.

Phase 2, if approved, would begin in Fiscal Year 2018-2019 and Phase 3 would be included as a budget request for Fiscal Year 2019-2020.


REMARKS: The funds for Phase 2 are included in the Fiscal Year 2018-2019 budget requests, and Phase 2 will proceed only if funds for the project are approved in the annual budget by City Council. Similarly, Phase 3 will proceed only if funds for the project are included in the Fiscal Year 2019-2020 budget. Staff is seeking authority to enter into this contract now to lock in the fee rates currently offered. The estimated cost for Phase 2 is \$538,960, including optional services, and the estimated cost for Phase 3 is \$676,580, including optional services.
