AN ORDINANCE

1 AUTHORIZING Collin Quigley to perform the duties of the City Manager of the City of
2 Springfield, Missouri, on an interim basis, until the newly appointed
3 City Manager commences employment which is anticipated to occur
4 on August 1, 2018; and declaring an emergency.

7 WHEREAS, current City Manager Greg Burris retires effective June 30, 2018;

10 WHEREAS, City Council has selected Jason Gage to be City Manager effective
11 August 1, 2018; and

13 WHEREAS, City Council desires to provide continuity for operation of City
14 government until Jason Gage takes office; and
15

16 WHEREAS, City Council acted on June 12, 2018, to authorize Collin Quigley to
17 perform the duties of the City Manager until Jason Gage takes office; and

19 WHEREAS, there is only one regularly scheduled Council meeting between June
20 12, 2018, and June 30, 2018; and

22 WHEREAS, the position of City Manager is a vital position within the City's
23 government, and an individual must be authorized to perform the duties of City Manager
24 to ensure the continuous and effective functions of City government.

26 NOW THEREFORE, BE IT ORDAINED BY THE COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF
27 SPRINGFIELD, MISSOURI, as follows, that:
28

29 Section 1 – Collin Quigley is hereby authorized and empowered to perform all
30 functions, duties, and obligations of the City Manager for the City of Springfield,
31 Missouri, effective July 1, 2018, until such time as the newly appointed City Manager
32 commences employment; and Collin Quigley is authorized to perform all said functions

33 and duties in his own name, on an interim basis, until such time as the newly appointed
34 City Manager commences employment, which is anticipated to be August 1, 2018.

36 Section 2 – City Council hereby finds and declares that an emergency exists in
37 that this Ordinance relates to the immediate preservation of public peace, property,
38 health, safety, or morals, due to the fact that the City must have an individual
39 designated to perform the functions and duties of the City Manager to ensure the
40 continuous and effective functions of City government. Therefore, this Ordinance shall
41 be in full force and effect from and after passage.


