EXHIBIT A

1-1330. Utilities

- A. Utility Distribution Facilities. Utility distribution facilities shall be exempt from the requirement of this Article except as follows:

3. Utility poles utilized for the support of electrical, telephone, cable television or other video services, street lighting, or other similar cables, and located within the rights-of-way or utility easements that serve as support structures for wireless telecommunications facilities. No attachment for wireless communications devices by a wireless provider shall be attached on a pole closer than four hundred (400) feet from another pole attachment by such provider for wireless communications devices as measured along either side of the easement or rights-of-way. This pole separation requirement, however, shall not apply to wireless communication devices utilizing low-power equipment, operating as an independent facility, with antennas mounted below the power lines, with the associated communications equipment mounted directly to the support structure/utility pole, and following all NESC codes. Such utility poles shall be placed in accordance with the following matrix based on the zoning classification in which the utility pole is located. City Planning and Development Authority shall also have authority to grant additional exceptions on a case by case basis.
