## Services from the Springfield-Greene County Health Department

**General Information:** (417)864-1684

**Birth or Death Certificates:** (417)864-1658 Certified Birth and Death Certificates are issued for births and deaths that occur in the state of Missouri. Fees apply.

**HIV /STD Testing:** (417)864-1684 – Monday through Friday 8 am to 3:30 pm and on Wednesdays, 8 am to 5 pm.  
Testing and treatment are free of charge.

**Immunizations:** (417)874-1220 - Tuesdays 7:30 to 10:00 a.m. (walk-in clinic) or by appointment. Childhood immunizations required for school entrance are provided at no cost. Located at 660 S Scenic Ave. 65802

**Lead Poisoning Nurse Case Management:** (417)874-1217

**Blood Lead Testing:** (417)874-1217 – By appointment only. Provided to Greene County residents at no cost.

**Tuberculosis Clinic:** (417)864-1697 – TB skin testing by appointment only. Skin test must be read within 48-72 hours after being administered and requires two visits to the clinic within this 72-hour period. This service is available for a fee of \$20.00. TB case management is available to individuals who have been exposed to a known case of TB; individuals showing symptoms of TB disease and individuals with TB disease or latent TB infection.

**WIC Office:** (417)851-1580 Located at 440 E. Tampa. Provides a supplemental food program for qualifying women who are pregnant or breastfeeding and for children up to 5 years of age. Provides breastfeeding classes, breastfeeding support, and nutrition education. Appointments call: (417) 851-1580

## **Pregnancy Testing/ Support**

Walk-in Free pregnancy testing Monday through Friday 7:30 am to 6:30 pm.

**Pregnancy Care Center:** (417)877-0800 1342 E. Primrose By appointment only. Provides free pregnancy testing, nutrition classes, twice weekly breast feeding and parenting classes/ultrasound up to 13 weeks (qualification requirements apply). Receive coupons for class attendance or participating in the mentoring program. Coupons can be redeemed for baby items including diapers, baby care products and clothing.

**Birthright:** (417)865-3430 305 1330 E Cherry Suite L-2. Emergency pregnancy site (similar to the Pregnancy Care Center). They give vouchers for cribs if you get your pregnancy test done there. Services are provided at no cost. Staffed by volunteers and funded through churches and donations.

**Planned Parenthood:** (417)883-3800 Provides pregnancy testing, annual paps, STD testing for females and males and birth control (pills, IUD, patch, depo shot). Services are provided for a fee and are based on a sliding scale.

**Doula Foundation:** (417)832-9222 1111 S. Glenstone Suite 2-101. Provides support for moms before, during and after childbirth. Offers classes on childbirth, post-partum, breastfeeding and newborn care.

Clothing Bank – purchase a card for \$1.00 and you can shop 1x/month for 12 months. The Emergency Food Pantry provides 3 visits per year (must not be back to back). Provides rental assistance to eligible individuals. Provides formula on a first-come, first-served basis (type of formula and amount varies as it is dependent on donations).

**Victory Mission:** (417) 831-6387 Monday through Friday 8 am to 5 pm  
Victory Mission's Family Outreach Ministry provides direct assistance and referral for food, clothing, household goods, medical treatment, transportation and counseling. VICTORY HOUSE – classes offered on parenting, job and life skills.

Participants can visit three times a year and must bring social security card for each member of the household. Participants must bring social security card, photo identification and proof of residence that is less than 30 days old. Also provides clothing vouchers on a quarterly basis.
