PACKAGE DEALS*

General Health Package (Most Popular!): This package includes the Complete Blood Count (CBC), Comprehensive Metabolic Panel (CMP), and the Thyroid Screening Hormone (TSH). **\$100**

Men's Cancer Package: This package includes the Prostate Cancer Screen (PSA) and the Colorectal Cancer Screening. **\$45**

INDIVIDUAL SCREENINGS

Hg A1C: This Diabetic test is newly approved as a screening for diabetes for those with an elevated glucose and provides average blood glucose level over the past 2-3 months to identify pre-diabetes or risk of developing Type 2 diabetes. **\$20**

Colorectal Cancer Screening: Recommended for men and women age 50 and up. The hemoccult kit is a take-home screening for colorectal cancer. **\$15**

CRP: (C-Reactive Protein) High levels of CRP indicates inflammation occurring in our blood vessels that can lead to heart disease. **\$30**

Prostate Cancer: The **PSA** is a screening test for prostate cancer. *Ask your doctor for recommendations regarding the PSA test and how often/if you should participate.* **\$40**

H & H: This test measures the amount of hemoglobin and hematocrit in the blood, testing your oxygen carrying ability and iron level (anemia). *Note: this is included in the CBC.* **\$20**

CBC: (Complete Blood Count) This screening checks for anemia, infection and other diseases. It is a panel of tests that examines different parts of the blood; white blood cell count, red blood cell count, hemoglobin, hematocrit, platelets, mean corpuscular volume, mean corpuscular hemoglobin, mean corpuscular hemoglobin concentration and red cell distribution width. **\$35**

CMP: (Comprehensive Metabolic Panel) This panel of tests provides your physician important information about the current status of your kidneys, liver, electrolyte and acid/base balance, blood sugar and blood proteins. Abnormal results may indicate a problem needs to be addressed. **\$40**

TSH: A thyroid-stimulating hormone, the TSH blood test checks for thyroid gland problems. **\$50**

Vitamin D: Vitamin D is important for good overall health and strong and healthy bones. It's also an important factor in making sure your muscles, heart, lungs and brain work well and that your body can fight infection. **\$30**
