Did you know only 1 in 4 Springfield drivers stops for walkers at crosswalks? Not only is it the law, it's the right thing to do.



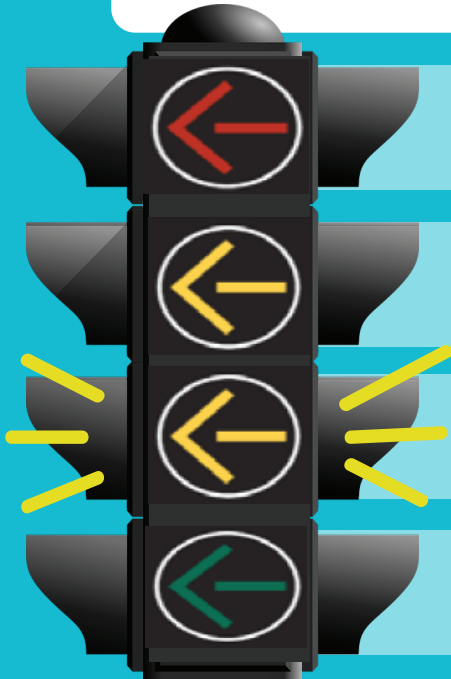
Be like THIS guy.



NOT these guys.



Some left turn signals now have flashing yellow arrows rather than green balls. They remind left turning drivers to yield to oncoming traffic.



STOP. SERIOUSLY!

Prepare to Stop!

Wait for oncoming traffic & crossing walkers, then go.

It's your turn to go!



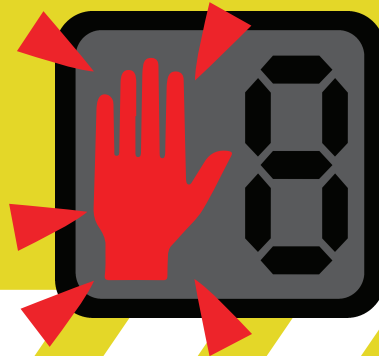
ALWAYS watch for walkers & yield to them at crosswalks & intersections!

Use CROSSWALKS where available and OBEY TRAFFIC SIGNALS

You may cross the street, but watch for turning cars.



Time to FINISH crossing - But don't start!



Don't cross the street. Push button if available.



On major roadways with a speed limit of 35 mph or more, you must cross at intersections or crosswalks or you could be ticketed for jaywalking.
