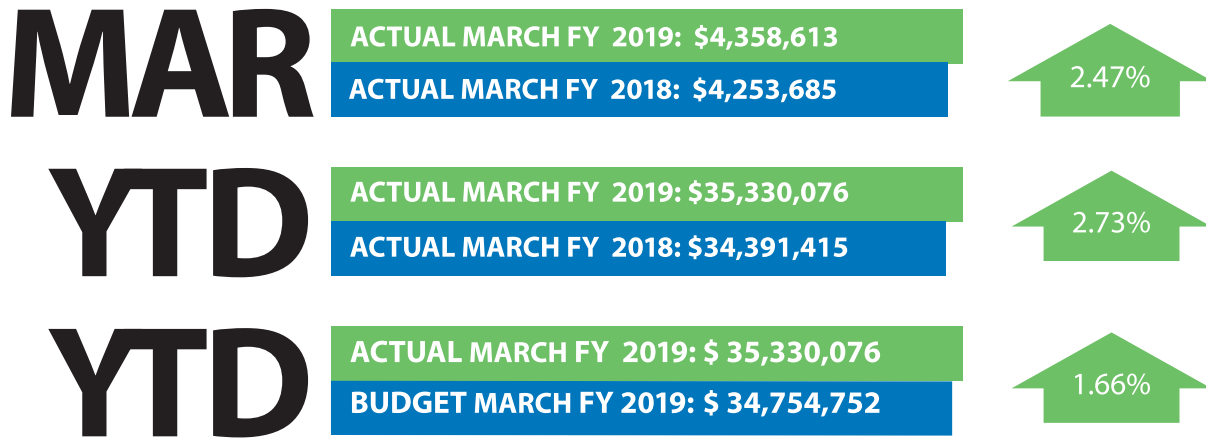


March sales tax revenue up 2.5%

The City of Springfield’s March sales tax revenues from the Missouri Department of Revenue are up 2.47 percent, or \$104,927, compared to March 2018. The check was \$4,358,613, compared to the March 2018 revenue check in the amount of \$4,253,685.

On a year-to-date basis, sales tax revenues are up 2.73 percent, or about \$938,000, compared with the same time frame in 2018.

The check reflects sales processed by the state in February from transactions made primarily in January.



The City heavily relies on sales tax revenues as its main source of revenue to fund vital services, such as police and fire operations. In Springfield, approximately 56% of revenue in the General Fund comes from sales tax and use tax.
