Springfield POLICE

Domestic violence is never trivial, excusable or deserved, and it is never the victim's fault. Perpetrators are exclusively responsible for their crimes and the subsequent effects.

Some warning signs of an abusive partner ...

- Extreme jealousy
- Controlling of your day-to-day activities
- Insults you and demeans or shames you with put-downs
- Has threatened to kill or harm you
- Destroys your property
- Has threatened to harm or take away your children

SPD is a mandated reporter for incidents involving domestic violence or child abuse and per Missouri Revised Statutes, we are required to investigate reports of those incidents. Our detectives will assist you in connecting with resources for your safety and well-being.

The investigation ...

- will be completed by the responding officer

OR

- your case will be assigned to a detective who will conduct further investigation if needed.

After the investigation ...

- Evidence will be presented to the Greene County Prosecutor's Office. They will then decide if charges will be filed.

OR

- The case will be suspended until further evidence or information is discovered.
