

## NOTICE TO CONTRACTORS

Notice No. 2707

Sealed bids for the **Battlefield Road and Fremont Avenue Intersection Improvements and Fremont Avenue Widening from Battlefield Road to Sunset Street** will be accepted at the City of Springfield, Busch Building, 840 Boonville, Springfield, MO 65802 until 10:30 a.m. **on January 7, 2020** and then publicly opened and read aloud in the 2<sup>nd</sup> floor West Conference Room of the Busch Building. Bids received after 10:30 a.m. will be returned unopened.

This project consists of widening Fremont Ave to 5 lanes. This will add one additional lane primarily on the east side of Fremont Ave. Project will include sidewalk on the east side of Fremont Ave and a multi-use trail on the west side. The drainage channel at Meador Park will be modified to a natural bottom channel with a native seed mix. The Fremont Ave and Battlefield Mall Entrance signal will be removed and updated. Battlefield Rd will be improved to add dual left turns from Battlefield Rd onto Fremont Ave. New intersection islands will be installed, and the Fremont Ave and Battlefield Rd signal will be removed and updated. ADA improvements will be included with this project. Battlefield Rd and Fremont Ave will also include a mill and overlay. City Utilities will be including Gas & Water relocations as well as Electric light pole bases.
