

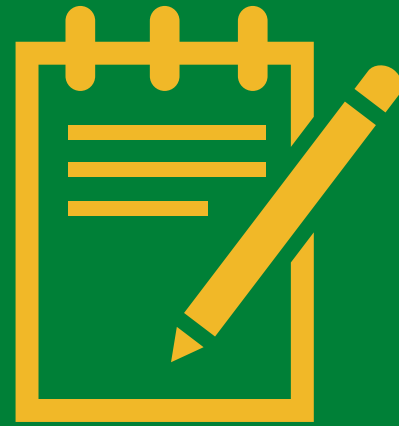
EMPLOYMENT DURING COVID-19

Apply for Unemployment

If you lost your job because of COVID-19, you can apply for Pandemic Unemployment--even if you were self-employed, working part-time, or working "gig" jobs.
