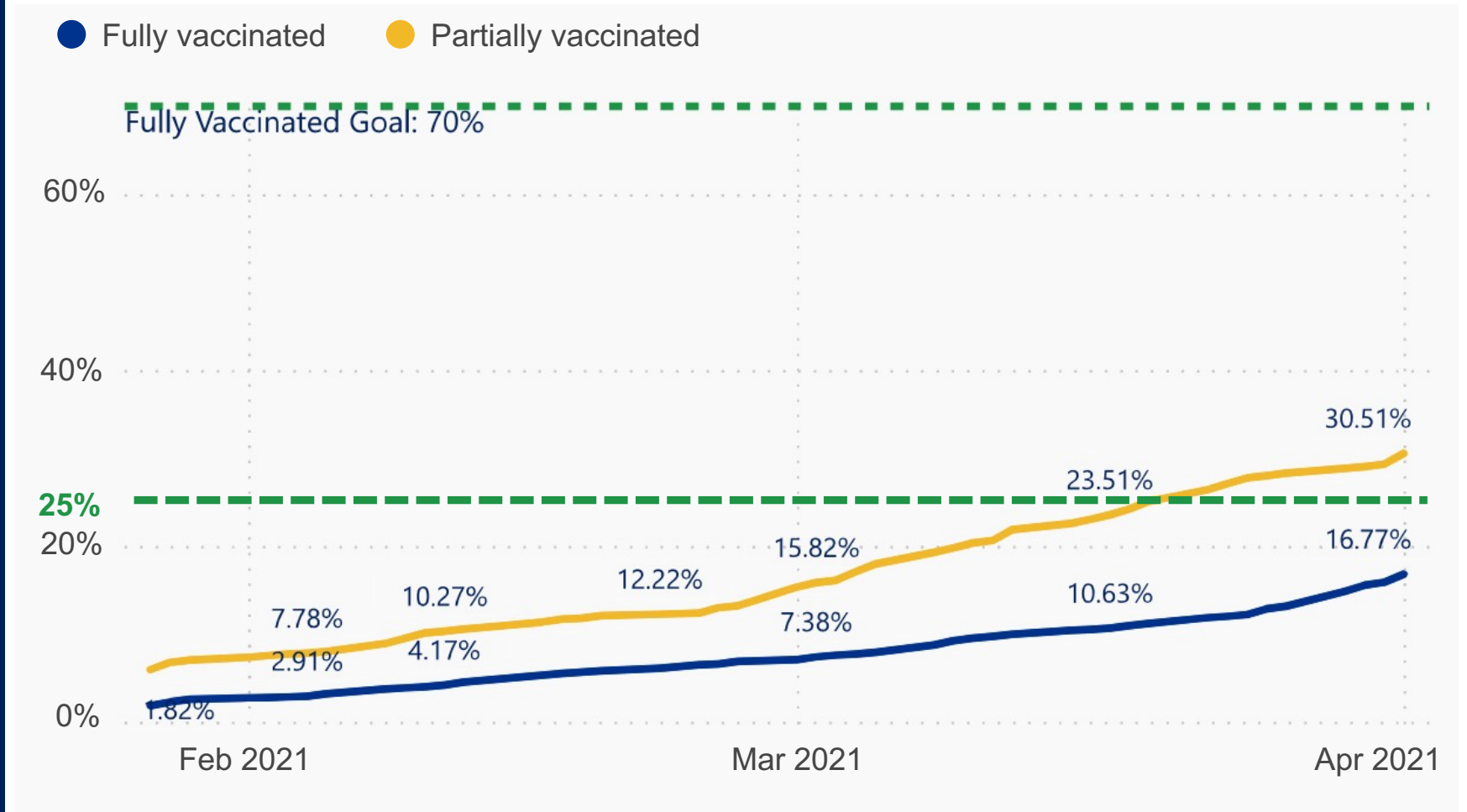

WHERE ARE WE NOW?

On March 24, we met the 28-day threshold requirements for our seven-day average and hospitalization numbers.

Currently, **16.8%** of our population 16+ is fully vaccinated. We need to be closer to 25%.

CURRENT STATUS: VACCINES



These numbers are for Greene County residents 16 and older who have received one or both doses of a COVID-19 vaccine.

COVID-19 VARIANTS

- **B.1.1.7** (discovered in the UK)
 - 30%-80% more effectively transmitted
 - May be associated with an increased risk of mortality
- **B.1.351** (discovered in South Africa)
 - Also thought to have a higher potential for transmission
- **P.1** (discovered in Brazil)
 - Thought to reinfect people more easily
- At this time, available vaccines are thought to cover variants, although effectiveness may be slightly decreased
- **We cannot let our guard down**

IMPORTANCE OF COMPLETING VACCINE SERIES

mRNA COVID-19 vaccines are highly effective in preventing infections in real-world conditions



Nearly 4,000* health care personnel, first responders, and essential workers were tested weekly for the virus that causes COVID-19



Those who were fully vaccinated[†] were **90% less likely** to get infected

* Effectiveness of Pfizer-BioNTech and Moderna mRNA vaccines among 3,950 study participants in eight U.S. locations from December 14, 2020, to March 13, 2021. Participants self-collected specimens weekly regardless of symptoms and collected additional specimens if they became sick.

[†] Fully vaccinated = 2 weeks after 2nd dose

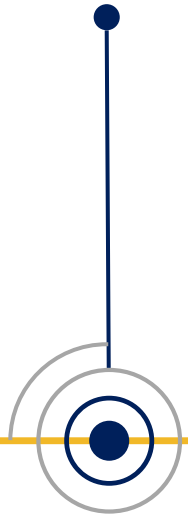

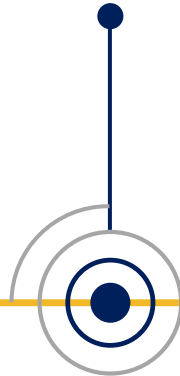
