

### Summary of the edits for the Citizen Participation Plan

1. Edits to the Conflict of Interest for the CACCD membership; updated based on recent legal review and compliance with the HUD regulations.
2. Updates to the HUD Notification and Consultation List
  - a. Delete some agencies that no longer exist or are not traceable
  - b. Some agency's names were changed
3. Clarify the policy on the relocation assistance for displaced persons. Add reference to the City's Anti-displacement and Relocation Assistance Plan and HUD's relocation requirements under Section 104(d) of the Housing and Community Development Act which supplements the Federal Uniform Relocation Act.
4. Update the Limited English Proficiency data provided by the OTO Limited English Proficiency Plan dated 2021.
5. Indicate that the 1<sup>st</sup> Years Annual Action Plan is included in the 5-Year Consolidated Plan.
6. Clarify that our annual action Plan submission date may change if HUD is delayed in getting the congressional allocation and they authorize a later submission timeframe.
7. Clarify that the notification to the public and the citizen participation time frames may be reduced when operating in a declared emergency such as the recent pandemic.
8. Adjust the allowance for a Substantial Change from 10% to 15% due to increased HOME and CDBG loan program costs.
9. Allow for Public Hearings by staff if the CACCD doesn't have a quorum and time is critical to meet HUD reporting and submission deadlines.
10. Update the Fair Housing Certification and Planning process to follow the proposed but not finalized changes in the HUD regulations.
